



Tracy Martin Peebles, Candidate for Juvenile Court Judge

Magistrate Tracy Martin Peebles serves as the delinquency magistrate for the Honorable Michael J. Ryan. She received a bachelor's degree from Cleveland State University in 1993 and a Juris Doctorate from University of Toledo in 1997. Her career began in her family legal practice, John W. Martin Co. and Associates, LPA. Followed by several years as an Assistant County Prosecutor for Cuyahoga County, beginning in Domestic Relations Court. During part of her tenure as an Assistant County Prosecutor, Tracy was assigned to the Community Based Unit, the initial unit based on geographic organization which was designed to stay involved with members of our respective communities and remain responsive to the communities' concerns.

In 2004, Tracy returned to her family legal practice. During her return to private practice, Tracy was appointed Prosecutor for the southeastern suburbs of Warrensville Heights and later for Maple Heights, while maintaining a private practice with a focus on juvenile defense. That practice served the families of Cuyahoga County until February of 2018 when she was selected by Judge Michael J. Ryan to be his delinquency magistrate.

While currently serving as magistrate, Tracy maintains a portion of Judge Ryan's delinquency docket, presides over Judge Ryan's Bridges cases for youth aging out of foster care and serves as the magistrate for Judge Ryan's Juvenile Reentry Court for Cuyahoga County youth. Judge Ryan is vacating this seat and running for the 8th District Court of Appeals. Tracy is passionate about the work she is currently doing and desires to make what will be a natural progression from magistrate to judge.

Tracy is married to Tony Peebles and they have 3 daughters. She is a member of Mt. Zion Congregational UCC, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. and the Ohio Association of Magistrates.
